This privacy policy discloses the privacy practices for <u>www.HopesDoorNY.org.</u> This privacy policy applies solely to information collected by this website. This policy will advise you of the following:

- 1. What personally identifiable information is collected from you through the website, how it is used and with whom it may be shared.
- 2. What choices are available to you regarding the use of your data.
- 3. The security procedures in place to protect the misuse of your information.
- 4. How you can correct any inaccuracies in the information.

Information Collection, Use, and Sharing

Hope's Door is the sole owner of the information collected on this site. We only have access to or collect information that you voluntarily give us via email or other direct contact. We will not sell or rent this information to anyone.

We will use your information to respond to you, regarding the reason you contacted us. We do not share your information with any third party outside of our organization, other than as necessary to fulfill your request (e.g. to ship an order or to respond to a request).

Unless you ask us not to, we may contact you via mail or email in the future to tell you about events, news pertaining to domestic violence, dating abuse or legislation impacting our victims and their families, or other important organizational announcements.

Your Access to and Control Over Information

- express any concern you have about our use of your data; or

Your Security

We take careful precautions to protect your information. When you submit sensitive information via the website, your information is protected both online and offline.

Wherever we collect sensitive information (such as credit card data), that information is encrypted and transmitted to us in a secure way.

Only employees who need the information to perform a specific job (for example, crisis response, billing or customer service) are granted access to personally identifiable information. The computers/servers in which we store personally identifiable information are kept in a secure environment.
