Advocate – STRIVE Initiative Statewide Targeted Reductions in Intimate Partner Violence

Overview of Position:

The Advocate will work in collaboration with police in Mount Vernon to support domestic violence survivors assessed as high-risk for homicide. The Advocate will enhance safety and support for survivors through assessment of danger, safety planning, skillful advocacy, court accompaniment, and coordination of services with our partners, which include the Office of the District Attorney, Mount Vernon PD, Yonkers PD, Probation, County Office for Women, and My Sisters' Place, among others.

Job Responsibilities

- Deliver and coordinate services for victims identified as high-risk for homicide.
- Conduct intake, danger assessments, safety planning, counseling, case management, and provide I&R.
- Provide crisis intervention
- Support on-call responses outside regular hours, as needed.
- Assist with outreach.
- Participate in team meetings and strengthen partnerships with community partners and others.
- Document services and submit accurate, timely reports.

Education and Experience: Bachelor's degree or equivalent combination of education and related work experience with victims and/or the criminal justice/law enforcement system.
